While I was only at only lasted a little more than six months, we were starting to see people form a vision for reaching the lost. The church membership was primarily composed of seniors and the focus of the church was inward. About three months into my pastorate I began teaching through the Baptist Faith and Message. When I reached Baptism and Lord's Supper, it became apparent the church leadership was not Baptist in doctrine. They informed me that they did not believe that Baptism by immersion was the only acceptable means of baptism. I strived for the next four months to help the church understand the importance of adhering to its own doctrinal statement, but to no avail. This is the only disappointment I have experienced in ministry, to find a Baptist Church that denied its Baptist heritage. Even with the leadership drawing slightly more than half the voting body (18-14) to follow them, in my time at IBC, I developed deep discipleship relationships with many of the members. Many of those who were in agreement with the Baptist Faith and Message, and it is with great sorrow I am unable to continue ministering as their pastor.
- July 1, 2005 First Baptist Church, Eakly, Oklahoma
Present Position Held: Senior Pastor
In my time at FBC Eakly, we have seen steady church attendance, restored a Biblical and Southern Baptist Mission focus. Four, and soon to be five, of our students have went on international mission trips through I Go Ministries, and we have taken one trip to Utah. Locally we started *Forth Wednesday outside the Building*, a program where we go into the community and do yard work, clean trash, and do repairs on homes for people who are physically unable because of either age or illness. We have also seen a return to the churches doctrinal and moral foundations, restoring an understanding of the Baptist Faith and Message and the Church Covenant.
- May 1998 to Red Hills Southern Baptist Church, Enoch, Utah
June 2005 Position Held: Senior Pastor
While serving at Red Hills and meeting in University classrooms with an average attendance of 25-30, we purchased land, and I designed and provided oversight of the construction of a new church plant for over 165 members. We used primarily volunteer Baptist construction workers from several different states allowing us to build a fully furnished Worship, Sunday School, and Fellowship facilities for \$44 a sq ft. In addition to building our own facility, we sponsored three new church works in neighboring communities. When I accepted God's call to FBC Eakly, Red Hills was running over 100 in Sunday School and Worship.

OTHER MINISTRY EXPERIENCE:

Vise-Moderator and Moderator and of Caddo Baptist Association for four years, and currently Sunday School and Discipleship Team leader. I have provided training in VBS, evangelism and other areas within the association. I served as moderator for five of seven years, and one year as volunteer interim Director of Missions in the Color Country Baptist Association in Utah. In the Utah-Idaho Southern Baptist convention I served on the Executive board in the capacities of Budget Committee Chairman and Vise-Chair of the Executive Committee.
